# General Information

- **JUNIORS AND UP: PLEASE BRING WHITE T-SHIRT FOR CRAFT.**
- Please limit the number of cars to camp and be prepared to carpool with parents outside of camp. Limit exception arrivals and departures of individuals. No cars past the Parking Shelter are allowed at any time.
- In case of emergency in camp: Extinguish any fires. Gear remains. Calmly leave by two or three cars. Meet parents at prearranged meeting spot in Brewster. Use your phone chain!
- NO SIBLINGS AT ALL IN CAMP. No men overnight.
- Girls must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- Troop leaders: Help out at activities, please do not stand around talking. The best form of support is participation.
- Emergency phones are at the Health Center, Walden and Tanglewood. Note: these are EMERGENCY phones only. You will need change.
- Report all accidents to either Hope Bak, Margie Hammond, or AnnMarie Verrino. Report accidents to council on Monday. If anyone in your troop is leaving camp unexpectedly, let an emergency coordinator know (Hope, AnnMarie, Margie or person at your unit marked by asterick).
- Garbage and recycling is at 4 pm. Please place tied up garbage by the side of the road before that time. Phil, the ranger, will pick up. SEPARATE recyclables (glass, plastic, clean foil and tin) in one bag and other garbage in a separate bag. If there is no pickup, make sure that you put the bags back in the cans.
- Be sure to secure food in the lockers provide in the kitchen units. There are furry friends in camp looking for a free meal. **No food, soap or candy is allowed in tents.**
- Ticks and mosquitoes can be found in camp. Please use discretion in wearing shorts.
- Use the KISS method: Keep It Simple Scout
- Bring a camera – It's great to have pictures.
- NO Radios or Alcoholic Beverages allowed in camp.
- Absolutely no smoking on trails or in shelters. If you must smoke, please do it only at the fire circles.
- Cabin and Site turnover;

All Cabins can and will be used by the entire community during the day on Saturday. Please make sure all troop gear is stowed in sleeping areas and main room is clear for use.

- Schedule Tent check with Phil
- Friday and Saturday nighters share the unit until 4 pm
- If you are a Friday night camper and want to stay for dinner on Saturday, see Hope for a location

# Camper Equipment List

Everyone is responsible for carrying their gear into camp.  
Gear should be secure and well marked with scout's name.  
Each camper should only have 2 pieces of gear.  
Everything must be packed, including food.  
Pack bedding, rain gear, and boots separately from other gear.  
You may use a large trash bag providing it is well packed, secured and has a handle with which you can carry it.

Permission slip: Please have on top of gear  
Money: \$. 50 to call home in case of emergency  
Medicine: All medicines must be turned over to the troop leader with a parent's letter of use and permission

Sleeping Bag (not a slumber bag) covered in plastic bag to protect from rain with name and troop #

Blanket (If cool weather is expected)

Flashlight with extra batteries

Sit Upon

1 Pajamas or sweats to sleep in

1 extra pants

1 sweatshirt

1-2 underwear

1-2 socks

1 short sleeve shirt

1 long sleeve shirt

1 Warm jacket

1 Boots extra shoes – **no open shoes or sandals**

Rain Gear – Poncho or full length rain coat (Absolutely **no umbrellas for girls!**)

Toiletries – soap, toothbrush and past, hair brush, hair ties, wash cloth in baggie, small light towel, tissues

Laundry Bag – plastic bag for wet/dirty clothes

Water Bottle

Optional:

SMALL stuffed animal, camera, sunglasses book and small pillow

NO Food, Candy or Gum in tents

NO Aerosol or pump sprays (this includes deodorants, bug spray, etc).

**NO Cell phones for the girls.** Leaders only!

Cooking Shelters at Rock Hill have food storage cabinets. Make sure everything is safely stored in these cabinets. A cooler is also available at each unit. Remember – there is limited electricity at the units.

There is also a place for cooking under the shelter that has a grill

Before starting a fire: make sure that there are water buckets at the campsite  
Only those people who have completed outdoor living skills training are allowed to start fires in the unit. All fires must be completely out before leaving the unit

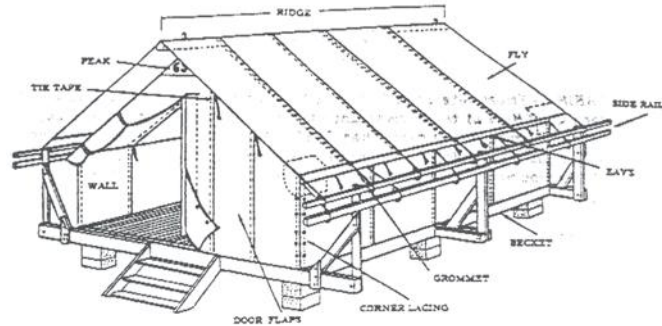

# Tent Handling and Maintenance

## Platform tents are not indestructible



### Please observe these precautions

- Always loosen the bottom ties and the corner ties before rolling flaps and sides of tent
- Door flaps and should be rolled inward
- Do not hang flaps/sides from ties
- Do not roll wet flaps/sides
- Tie tapes in half bow so they can be untied when wet
- **ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING IN TENTS**
- Do not hang anything on guy ropes or from tie tapes
- Do not move cots/mattresses from tent to tent
- No writing or pinning anything to the walls
- Keep mirrors covered (reflected sunlight can burn tent material)
- Do not use aerosols in tent – it will dissolve the water proofing
- When wet – do not touch the tent – it will allow water to start leaking in

### Before leaving your campsite

- Secure all tents to platform
- Sweep out tents
- **Pick up papers/trash from around/in tents**
- Leave door flaps down and tied with half bow
- Make sure wash house is clean
